THE BERNARD JOHNSON AWARD

The Bernard Johnson Award is given by the Committee, on the recommendation of the adjudicators, to an outstanding performer, aged 16-25 as at 1st January of year of Festival, in Music, Speech & Drama, or Dance. The Award is to be used by the winner towards further studies in the discipline in which he/she entered the Festival. Competitors must have entered the Festival for more than one year in order to be considered for this award.

SUFFOLK FREE PRESS ANNIVERSARY CUP

This cup was presented to the Festival by the Suffolk Free Press to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the paper's first edition, published in July 1855. It will be given on the recommendation of the adjudicators, to the most promising performer, aged 15 or under as at 1 January in the year of the Festival, in Music, Speech & Drama or Dance.
